# Pillar 1: Encounter God

## 🔥 Regular Guest Speakers & Ministry Partners

### Purpose:

To intentionally make room for the fivefold ministry through trusted voices who enrich our church with their unique anointings and perspectives.

### Outcomes:

- Fresh impartation into the house
- Broader Kingdom connection
- Equipping and faith-building moments

## Ὕ Worship & Prayer Nights

### Purpose:

Dedicated nights purely for seeking God, worship, prophetic flow, intercession, and spiritual renewal.

### Rhythm:

Quarterly or bi-monthly.

### Outcomes:

- Spiritual depth and encounter
- Stronger prayer culture
- Leadership refreshing in His presence

## ◎ Leadership Development Gatherings

### Purpose:

To equip and grow leaders spiritually, relationally and practically.

### Rhythm:

Quarterly leadership huddles.

### Outcomes:

- Strengthened leadership core
- Practical skill development
- Spiritual impartation for those who serve

# Pillar 2: Build Family



## Family Park Days (Instead of Sunday Service)

**Purpose:** To take the church outside the building and intentionally build community, connection, and relational discipleship in a relaxed, family-friendly environment.

**Rhythm:** Selected Sundays throughout the year.

### **Outcomes:**

- Stronger family connection
- Safe and open environment for newcomers
- Intergenerational interaction

## Themed Sunday Lunches

**Purpose:** To build community and celebrate diversity by introducing meals from different cultures and nations, making church feel like family around the table.

**Examples:** Polynesian Sunday Lunch, Filipino Feast, Italian Sunday, Indian Curry, Aussie BBQ

### **Outcomes:**

- Cultural appreciation and honour
- Hospitality as discipleship
- Stronger belonging

## Marriage & Family Nights

**Purpose:** Strengthen families by providing wisdom, support, mentoring and biblical teaching.

**Examples:** Date-night workshops, Parenting support sessions, Family worship nights.

### **Outcomes:**

- Resourced and healthier families
- A culture of mutual support
- Strong biblical foundations for the home

# Pillar 3: Engage Our World

## Themed Sunday Services

**Purpose:** To create engaging, interactive worship experiences that connect faith to real-life themes while remaining spiritually rich and biblically grounded.

**Examples:** Hope Sunday, Testimony Sunday, Youth Takeover, Nations Sunday, Community Outreach Sunday

### Outcomes:

- Greater engagement; Participation across different ministries
- Innovation in worship expression

## Water Baptism & Testimony Sundays

**Purpose:** Create intentional moments to celebrate salvation, transformation and faith decisions.

### Outcomes:

- Public declaration of faith
- Storytelling culture strengthened
- Faith is made visible and celebrated

## Youth & Young Adult Activation Days

**Purpose:** Create safe, high-energy spaces for young people to encounter God, discover calling, and be mentored.

### Outcomes:

- A vibrant next generation
- Clear pathways for discipleship
- Leadership development for young adults



# Pillar 4: Bless Our City



## Community Blessing Initiatives

**Purpose:** To be intentional about loving and serving our city through practical support and outreach.

**Examples:** Food-bank partnerships; Bless a school drive; Clothing or backpack blessings; Serving days with REKON youth.

### Outcomes:

- Genuine relationships with the community;
- A reputation as a church that loves well;
- The gospel demonstrated through action.

Instead of a church-provided lunch, we will encourage our church family to invite others out to lunch from 12:10pm–1:30pm.

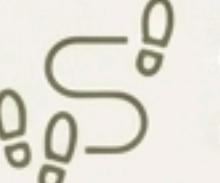
