- 1. Eligibility: (for complete eligibility requirements, please visit www.comoxvalleyrd.ca/woodstove)
- Applicants must be registered owners of legal dwelling units on properties within the borders of the Comox Valley Regional District which includes homes within the City of Courtenay, Town of Comox, Village of Cumberland and CVRD Electoral Areas.
- Must have replaced a functioning non-CSA\EPA wood stove appliance used as the home's primary heating source with a CSA\EPA certified wood burning unit, a high efficiency natural gas fireplace, electric insert, pellet stove or electric air-source heat pump.
- Application must be signed and completed by the applicant and participating retailer. The Tracking Number will be provided by the participating retailer.
- It is the responsibility of the applicant to submit the application to the CVRD.
