## THURSDAY NIGHT CO-ED BCA LEAGUE BY-LAWS 2025 – 2026 Season

- 1. MEMBERS OF A TEAM: Teams will have 4 players per team, this is a co-ed league, so there must be at least one person of the opposite sex on the team. It will not be allowed to have an all-male team or an all-female team.
  - a. TEAM ROSTERS: Team rosters must be turned in prior to the start of the league.
  - **b. NOTE:** If a sub is necessary to fill in for a team member, there still will need to have one person of the opposite sex playing that match. NO EXCEPTIONS.
  - c. If a team fails to follow these rules and plays all male or all female players in a match, the subbed in player(s) points will be forfeited and the opposing player will receive 10 points for each game the illegal player played.
  - **d.** A PLAYER CAN ONLY PLAY ONE MATCH PER WEEK. CANNOT PLAY FOR TWO DIFFERENT TEAMS IN THE SAME WEEK.
  - e. Roster players cannot play City league and the BCA league, must play one or the other.
    - 1. If this occurs, the offending player loses their points for the night the infraction occurred.
  - **f.** In the event of a bye week, no roster players can sub for another team.
  - **g.** All players on the league must be 21 years old or older to play. Any violation of this rule will result in that player losing their points for the week and are awarded to the opposing players for that match.
- **2. SUBSTITUTE PLAYERS:** Roster players can only play for their team. Substitute players can play for any team in the league if they are on the sub list of players.
  - **a.** MUST HAVE AT LEAST 2 ROSTER PLAYERS SHOOT EACH MATCH. ONLY 2 SUBS ALLOWED PER MATCH. STACKING TEAMS IS NOT ALLOWED.
  - **b. NOTE:** Players who sub for a team may choose to sub only for that team and not be on the sub list.
- **3. ROSTER CHANGES:** If a roster player needs to be removed for any reason, please inform the president or secretary of the change as soon as possible so the opposing teams know who the roster players are and the roster list can be updated.
- 4. START TIME: Official start time will be 7:00 pm. (Actual time, not bar time).
  - **a.** Late Teams are allowed a 15-minute leeway before a forfeit occurs. Please contact the opposing team if you will be late.
  - **b.** A match can start with only 2 players present at start time.
- **5. GAME PLAY:** All games will be singles games. Each player will play all members of the opposing team once during each match. 4 games per person each match, a total of 16 games will be played each match.
- **6. COACHING:** No coaching any player while they are shooting!! Coaching means advising a player how or what to shoot while a player is shooting or between shots during players turn up. Coaching will result in loss of game.
  - a. NOTE: Players must ask the opposing team Captain on any rule clarifications.
- 7. **SCORING:** The winner of the game receives 10 points, 7 points for the object balls all being pocketed, the 8-ball pocketed legally is worth 3 points. The loser of the match receives one point for each of their object balls pocketed.
  - **a. FOR EXAMPLE:** The player who pockets all their object balls and legally pockets the 8-ball receives 10 points. The loser of the match pocketed three of their object balls prior to the 8-ball being pocketed, they receive 3 points for the match.
  - **b. NOTE:** No one receives points for any remaining object balls left on the table.
- **8. WEEKLY DUES:** Dues for each match will be \$5.00 per person or \$20.00 per team. The home team collects both their dues as well as the opposing team's dues and is responsible for turning in the scoresheet and weekly dues for that match.
  - **a. NOTE:** Please turn in a \$20 bill from each team for ease of counting the money.

- **9. SCORESHEETS AND WEEKLY DUES:** Must be turned in on the night of the match to McCabe's Pub in the Thursday Night City Pool League Box located behind the Keno Desk.
  - a. Please fill out the score sheets completely
    - 1. Do not forget to mark all break and runs (B & R) as well as 40-point wins. If these are not marked on the scoresheet that is turned it, it will not be rewarded, **NO EXCEPTIONS**!!
- **10. ALTERCATIONS DURING MATCHES:** If an altercation during a match occurs, stop play, and discuss the issue before the next shot occurs. If game play is allowed to resume, the issue is null and void. If the issue cannot be resolved, call an officer. Altercations WILL NOT BE TOLERATED and handled as follows:
  - a. 1st Altercation/Complaint: 1st Warning from the officers.
  - **b.** 2<sup>nd</sup> Altercation/Complaint: Meeting will be scheduled with the officers of the league and both teams that were involved. 2<sup>nd</sup> warning will be given and be informed that a 3<sup>rd</sup> infraction will be removal from the league.
  - **c.** 3rd Altercation/Complaint: Individual and/or team will be removed from the league for the season.
- 11. END OF SEASON TOURNAMENT: League voted to do an ALL-PLAYER DOULBES TOURNAMENT rather than an MVP Tournament at the end of the season to be held on Saturday, March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026.
  - **a.** Doubles teams will be made up of the 1<sup>st</sup> place and 4<sup>th</sup> place players and 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place players from each team.
  - **b.** 20% of the remaining monies will be devoted to be used for the day of the tournament.
  - **c.** Lunch will be provided by the league for all players on the league.

## 12. OFFICERS PAYMENT:

- a. Each roster player will pay \$20 the first week of play. All subsequent weeks will be \$5 per person or \$20 per team.
  - 1. \$5 will be to play that first week and the other \$15 will go to pay the league officers for running the league.
  - 2. First week of play Envelope must have \$160
- **13. PAYOUTS AT THE END OF THE SEASON:** The remaining money after the league is over will be dispersed as follows:
  - a. ROLL-OVER LEAGUE COSTS: \$200.00 will be left in the account for the following year's league.
  - **b. BREAK & RUNS:** Any player who has a break and run will receive \$5.00 per break and run.
  - **c. 40 POINT MATCHES:** Any player who won all 4 games and got 40 points in one match will receive \$5.00 per 40-point match.
  - **d. PERFECT ATTENDANCE:** Any player who does not miss a week of play will receive \$20 at the end of the season.
  - e. MEAL PROVIDED FOR END OF YEAR DOUBLES TOURNAMENT: Monies used for the tournament meal will be deducted from the total money collected for the season prior to Team Payouts being determined.
  - f. OVERALL MVP & RUNNER-UP LEAGUE MVP: Will receive \$100 and \$50 respectively.
  - **g. TEAM PAYOUTS:** Teams who place 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> will receive additional money at the end of the regular season as follows:
    - 1. 1<sup>st</sup> Place: 30% of the remaining monies
    - 2. 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: 25% of the remaining monies
    - 3. 3rd Place: 15% of the remaining monies
    - 4. 4th Place: 10% of the remaining monies
    - 5. 5<sup>th</sup> Place thru Nth Place: 10% of 1<sup>st</sup> Place Payout...i.e. if 1<sup>st</sup> Place receives \$400, all teams below 4<sup>th</sup> Place would receive \$40 (\$400 x 0.10 = \$40).
    - 6. 20% of the remaining monies will go to the end of year tournament payouts and drawings.
