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How to Access HNHB Regional Groups

Why set your eConsult Priority Region?

Setting your Priority Region(s) to 'Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant' allows you access to local specialists within the HNHB Regional Managed Specialty Groups.

If you do not select a priority region, or if there is no specialty group in your chosen region(s), cases are answered through the relevant Provincial Managed Specialty Group.

Accessing Service Settings

1. Sign in at otnhub.ca, click the User Panel link in the top right banner. A User/Self-Service panel appears.
2. Click the Services link in the panel. The Services screen appears.
3. To view the eConsult options, locate the row titled eConsult and click its associated Settings icon (⚙️)

Priority Regions
