





A message from the President



Wow, February is already here. Cold weather, warm hearts, Valentine's Day, high gas and electric bills, my first official Board Meeting and only 28 days until March. I can't believe I was nervous before the meeting, but after greeting everyone it all came back to me, I think this is my 11th year on the Board and maybe my toughest meeting.

At the Board Meeting last Saturday, a Special Assessment of \$36 was approved by the Board of Directors for 3 months. This assessment will start this April. We had no choice but to vote for it. When I spoke at the November meeting, we had \$126 in our Operating Account. I gave a new corrected Budget to the Board and members that showed that we would be \$48,000 over Budget by July. The Board voted to discontinue contributions to our Reserve Account saving us \$4400 a month until we can afford to pay back into it. Water for Common Area was turned off for a month to also save money. We also discussed continuing the dues rate increase of \$36 for next year's Budget. Everything has gone up and the Association was absorbing the increased cost. We cannot do this anymore. The continued rate increase will be discussed

in detail at the March meeting when the new Budget will be voted on. Ralston Management will send out notices of the assessment hopefully this week. You will have the opportunity to have the extra \$36 automatically deducted from your checking account or be billed for the increase for 3 months. I would like to thank the members that attended the meeting for their support and understanding.

We now must be an Association of volunteerism to help keep our costs down. We need walkers, a phone tree committee, Social Committee, and members to work in the office copying notices that will be handed over to our walkers and delivered to our members.

Donna Brown designed a new hat that will be popular in the Community. "Make Whispering Great Again." This is not political but what we need to do for the next couple of years to get our Operating Account back where it needs to be.

I hope you will now attend Board meetings. They are informational and fun. You can ask questions, complain, or show up to see what is going on in our community.

Hope to see you at the next Board Meeting on the 22nd of February. Stay warm and have a great February.




Bermuda/Gilbert gates contact:

- 1. When the power goes out the front entrance gate will automatically open within 30 seconds.
- 2. When the power goes out Call Bruce Anthony only if the Gates are not open.
- 3. Bermuda/Gilbert Gate will be opened first by Richard Juliano, who lives next to that gate within 15 minutes of no power.
- 4. The Bahama /Gilbert Street gate will be opened manually by Bruce Anthony, a member of the WPHOA Board or by one of the Gate Keepers.
- The Palm Street Exit gate will be opened manually if needed by Bruce Athony who is in charge of the gates or by a member of the WPHOA Board.
- 6. The Gates will be closed after power has been restored for 1 hour.
