HDR photography is a new technique that combines multiple photos with different exposures to produce a stunning final image. The result is a genuine picture of something real, but with a surreal and often jaw-dropping effect. Homes have never looked so good. Here is an example (pay attention to the windows):

## #1 Sell Homes Faster

**ANSWER—Aerial Photography and Professional HDR Indoor Photos!**

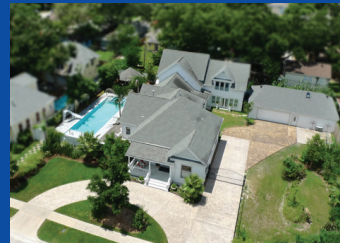
