Summit Purpose

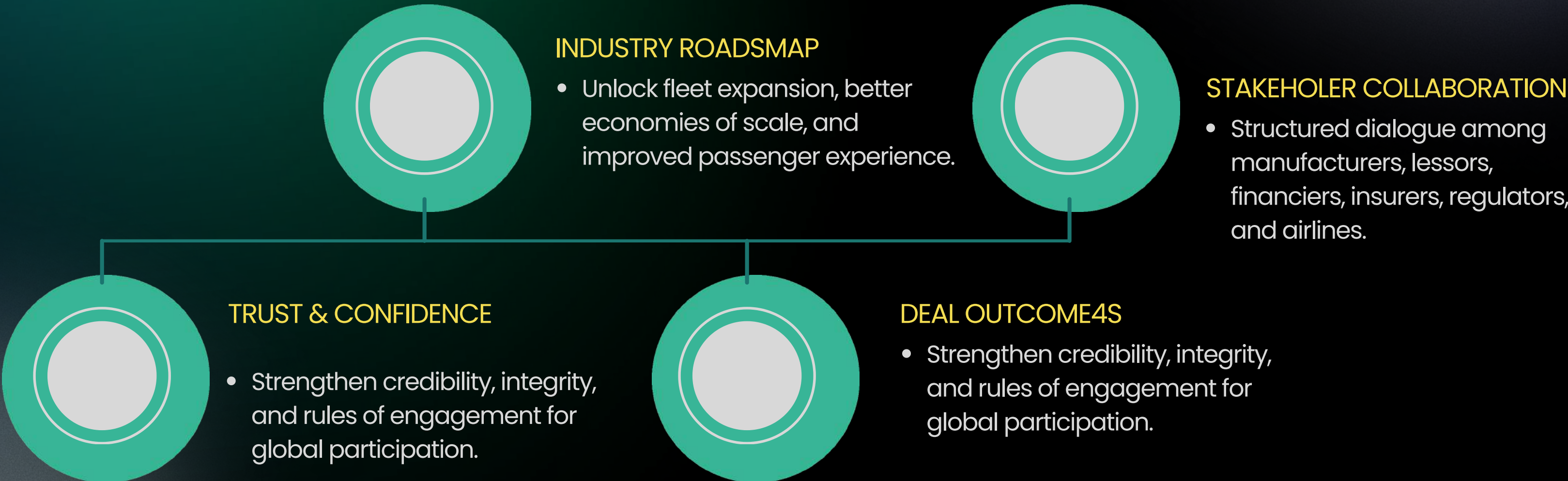

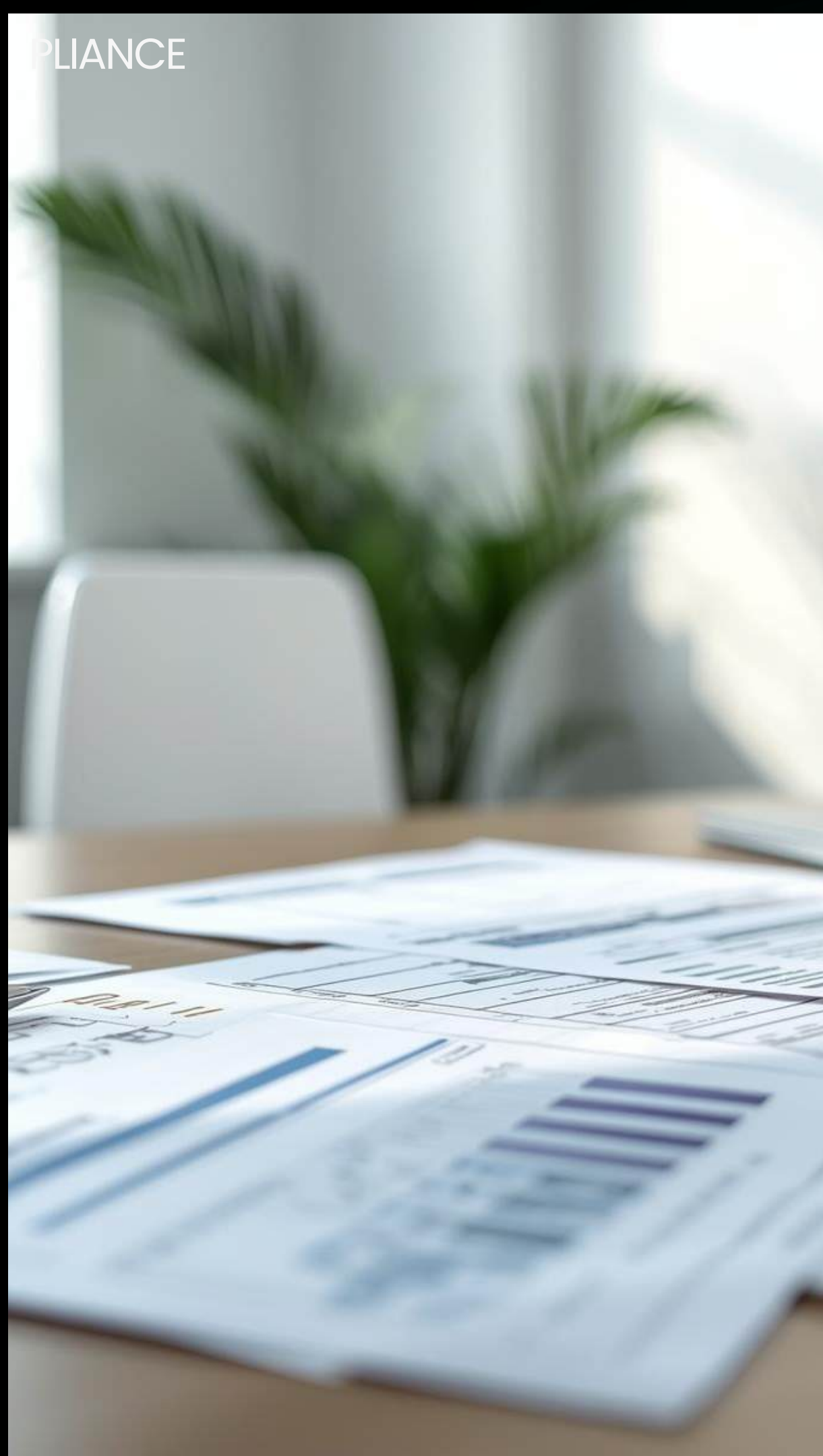
WHAT MAKES THIS SUMMIT DIFFERENT
