




MAKE YOUR VOICE HEARD | PETITION IS OPEN UNTIL MAY 28

Proposed Alto High-Speed Rail & Bill C-15

Following up on our most recent News Flash regarding information sessions about the Alto high speed train tracks, possibly being developed in our area, we would now like to inform you that a federal petition has been opened by Scott Reid, Member of Parliament Lanark - Frontenac, regarding the proposed Alto high-speed rail project and provisions contained in Bill C-15.



The petition raises concerns about the potential impact of the proposed high-speed rail corridor on rural communities, agricultural lands, environmental review processes, and federal spending priorities. In particular, it questions the extraordinary powers outlined in Bill C-15 to expedite rail corridor approvals and calls for reconsideration of the current approach.

The petition opened at the end of February (2026), and will close on **May 28, 2026, at 9:31 a.m. (EDT)**. If you would like to review the full text of the petition and decide whether to sign, you may do so using this link:
