ARTIST'S STATEMENT/INFORMATION

Inspirations and Preferred Subjects: My recent large scale, realistic charcoal drawings are auto-biographical narratives exploring many themes as I get older: personal relationships, family relationships, failing and reconnecting memory, dementia, abandonment, domestic violence all drawn in the flavor of surrealism and sometimes religious themes set in modern dream-like scenarios. Shape repetition and circles appear in my drawings to isolate specific areas, suggest halos and enhance the design. All drawings are created through a toned paper process and created in layers of varying charcoals, white conté and erasing.

The drawings have a strong narrative style and will border on photo-realism at times. I enjoy working with heavy contrast and rich value scales creating a Caravaggio-esque scene in charcoal.

Artists who inspire me are Michelangelo, Caravaggio, Millais, Thomas Eakins, Chuck Close, Frida Kahlo and more recently, John Currin, Paul Fenniak, and Ethan Murrow. My realistic work is done in the style of Italian and Southern Baroque Art, creating drama through lighting and darkness and at times, through the climax of the event depicted or the end result. Some of my drawings are direct salutes to specific Old Masters drawings. Some of the figures I draw will be distorted in proportions to emphasize space and to mimic close range photography.

Materials, Methods, and Processes: Stonehenge paper or Arches hot pressed watercolor paper, Prang paper-wrapped charcoal pencils, compressed charcoal sticks, vine charcoal, white conté, kneaded and plastic erasers, eraser pencils, and tissue paper. Pastel drawings are created with Conté A Paris pastel pencils and Nu Pastel sticks.

I began by toning my paper through scraping compressed charcoal onto a clean piece of large paper. Using tissue paper, I smudge the flakes of charcoal using short swirls until I get a medium smooth tone. The paper is transferred to an easel which has a large piece of drywall attached. Tacking the drawing with pushpins to the drywall, I draw standing up typically. The drawing is lightly sketched with an eraser and/or vine charcoal. Full values come early, completing sections of the drawing to the fullest degree before moving on to the next. I use hard charcoals first, creating hard edge lines and grayer values and then move to the mediums and soft as I near the finish for the richer blacks.

The ideas/images themselves start in my sketchbook and are realized more thoroughly through my own digital photography. I will pose my subjects or myself in dramatic lighting and photograph them in a variety of poses, reassemble the images in Photoshop, using layers, and adjusting values, and at times, combining completely different images into one coherent image to work from. The drawings are generally conceived before execution with an occasional room for conceptual change as I progress.

Auto-Biography: I have a BFA in Painting, 1988, an MA in Drawing, 1991, both degrees from Murray State University. I also have an MFA in Drawing, 1995, minor in Printmaking, from the University of Cincinnati. I began drawing as a child, like most artists, and didn't take it seriously until I took a freshman drawing class at Murray for fun. In the summers of 1986 and 1988, I toured Great Britain, Scotland, Wales, and Ireland in a student study abroad program based in London.

My main medium is charcoal, but I enjoy graphite pencils, conté, pastels, and printmaking in general. Photography is another interest but as a means to create drawings.

Currently, I am a Professor of Art at the Paducah School of Art and Design teaching Drawing I, II, Life Drawing, Introduction to Art, and Survival Skills for the Artist (Portfolio Development). I have been a recipient of two Kentucky Arts Council Grants in 2005 and 2007. During the summer months, I teach photography and drawing for the Kentucky Institute for International Studies and have visited Costa Rica, Panama, Italy, France and most of Europe.
