NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

In compliance with the provisions of Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, notice is hereby given of a Regular Meeting of the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners of Atascosa County Emergency Services District No. 2 to be held at **Atascosa County Gillespie Memorial Annex 25 East 5th Street, Leming, Texas at 6 p.m., March 3, 2026.**

The following agenda items will be considered, discussed, and action taken as appropriate:

- 1) Call to order and establish a quorum.
- 2) Recognition of Citizens.
- 3) Citizens Comments (three minutes per citizen).
- 4) Reading and approval of the minutes of January 6, 2025, Regular Meeting.
- 5) Treasurer's Report.
- 6) Report of Service Providers in District territory and action as necessary on same:

Report from representatives of each Volunteer Fire Department in the District on emergency or non-emergency incidents to which it responded in District territory from June 1, 2025 to present, if any, and presentation of all of its organizational and corporate documents, including, but not limited to, Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, budgets and ledgers for the preceding 5 years, federal and state tax exemption documentation, tax returns filed for the past 5 years, insurance, rosters of personnel, certifications, and ranks, three- and five-year plans, and inventories of real and personal property.

- 7) Consider, discuss, and take appropriate action on the following items:
 - a. Discussion on development of website for AESD2
 - b. Recap of sessions attended at SAFE-D Annual Conference
 - c. Publish notice of street address of the district's administrative office in newspaper of general circulation each January per Section 775.036.

- d. File annual report with the Texas Division of Emergency Management per Section 775.083.
- e. Potential contract(s) for the provision of emergency services, including fire, rescue, hazardous materials, first responder, and other related services with local emergency services organizations.
- f. Interim provision of emergency services by emergency services organizations currently servicing District territory.
- g. Selection of insurance provider for District and possible presentation by VFIS of Texas on same.
- h. Discuss a request for proposal for certified public accounts to conduct audits for District and contractor(s) to District.

* The District reserves the right to consider and take action on the above agenda items in any order. It also reserves the right to enter into a closed meeting on any agenda item as allowed by law. A Citizens Comment Form must be filed with the Secretary at least 10 minutes prior to the beginning of the meeting for an individual to be allowed to speak during Citizen Comment. By completing the Citizen Comment Form, the individual understands and acknowledges that the public is not entitled to choose the items to be discussed by the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners. The individual executing the Citizen Comment Form understands that he/she is provided a limited amount of time, and that he/he may not be allowed to continue to address the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners if the comments are rude, disparaging or defamatory to any individual or entity, or the comments become disruptive to the good order of the meeting. If at a meeting of a governmental body, a member of the public or of the governmental body inquires about a subject for which notice has not been given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, the notice provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act do not apply to a statement of specific factual information given in response to the inquiry; a recitation of existing policy in response to the inquiry; or, any deliberation of or decision about the subject of the inquiry shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a subsequent meeting. It should be noted that pursuant to Section 38.13, Texas Penal Code, HINDERING PROCEEDINGS BY DISORDERLY CONDUCT: (a) A person commits an offense if he intentionally hinders an official proceeding by noise or violent or tumultuous behavior or disturbance; (b) A person commits an offense if he recklessly hinders an official proceeding by noise or violent or tumultuous behavior or disturbance and continues after explicit official request to desist; and, (c) An offense under Section 38.15, Texas Penal Code is a Class A misdemeanor.
