A note from the President

Dear Friends,

Once again, a warm hello and thank you for giving me this opportunity to present to you our third Annual Report.

247 million children were impacted when COVID-19 resulted in the closure of over 1.5 million schools across India. 600 days of school shutdown amounting to almost 14000 hours of learning loss have practically stalled any form of education or learning that was prevalent in the country – if not for all - but for majority of the nation's children.

What happened between 2020 and 2021 is bound to have repercussions felt in 2027 and beyond.

All this means, we have a huge responsibility ahead of us. The parents of the family we support are looking at us for helping their children sail through these turbulences. And WE WILL!

Thanks to all your support, we did not let the school shutdown stop the learnings for any of the 100+ orbit shifters.10,000+ hours of tutoring support were provided collectively across our 5 centers through both physical and virtual (for most of the year) channels. We also had the opportunity to venture into our first rural center in Kerala through partnership with a local NGO. The center added another 140+ students to our family and gave us a chance to experiment with our remote delivery of educational support.

Thanks to well-wishers like you, Our Year 3 also saw us grow our reach from **78 to 240+ families**. We now operate from 5 locations (covering 10+ communities) in Bangalore and Rural Kerala. We now have 14 staff – all with a unified dream of doing everything possible to support our future leaders with their education.

Yes – If you haven't noticed it yet – The "sapling" in our cover page has grown further from last year's annual report!

Needless to say, none of this would have been possible without our well-wisher's encouragement and our donors trust.

With our bigger audacious dream for the future, we once again seek all your well wishes and support in making this dream as much as yours as it is ours!

The orbits are shifting! Help us shift more!

We are a nonprofit organization focused on embracing the economically challenged families and providing them a sustained support to continue their children's educational journey.


We love to imagine ourselves as the "Uber for the low income family's educational journey"

We strongly believe education is a life altering tool that can help "defeat" the vicious cycle of inter-generational poverty. However we also learnt that continuing this educational journey is an overwhelming ordeal for the economically challenged families! The "cracks" and the "constraints" surrounding their lives are just too many for them to continue keeping their children's "education" as their priority! That's the issue that bothers us deeply!

Simply put -We are on a mission to do "everything" possible to support low-income families with their children's education










Our Approach

We start on the premise that we are ill equipped to understand any problem that we ourselves don't face, no matter how empathetic we may think we are. Also we strongly believe in a long term involvement where we are with the family for anywhere between 5 to 10 years. Once inducted we start a series of **Human Centered Design Iterations** with the family to solve EVERY hurdle that might impair the ability of their child to complete their education. We do this by either connecting them to existing solutions or funding them.



Our Core Interventions through the journey of the child





Our Impact so far and road ahead



We strongly believe **that the only metrics** that matters to us is the "destination" that we dream for each of our cohorts. In fact we call each of our cohorts NOT by the year of them joining us, but the year they will graduate and get their job!

Our Year 1 journey had 21 families who had embraced us for helping them in their child's educational journey.

In Year 2 - We had 80+ families across 5 locations in Bangalore.

Now in Year 3 - We have 250+ families across 10 locations in Bangalore and Rural Kerala (through our Local NGO Partner). The children's age ranges from 12 to 20 and are currently studying in different grades / schools and colleges.

Hopefully our "satellite centers" staffed with our own alumni/teachers from the community will soon start playing the role of "force-multipliers" and uplift the 250-200 households in each of the communities we touch!

Our intervention at this point includes taking over full/partial finances of their school expenses, bi-monthly progress check with schools and parents, training and supporting hand-picked tuition teachers/field staff in filling the ed-gaps and lastly mentoring/counselling sessions with both parents and children. We are also constantly in talks with partner organizations on providing other services like Career Awareness, skilling and more that will help families get the best towards educating their child!









