<p>1. Gardet Brut Tradition NV   Chigny les Roses, France (Magnum) The palate grows in the glass and seems more expressive and elegant, with a full-bodied consistency, fine acidity and a balance between creamy roasted nut and brioche flavours and bold, steely acidity.</p>	18.20	25.20	35.80	107.00
<p>2. Laurent-Perrier Brut Nv   Tours-sur-Marne, Champagne (Magnum) Pale gold in colour with a delicate and complex nose. Hints of citrus fruit and white flowers. The palate is full-bodied, complex and creamy, displaying length to finish.</p>	26.50	36.90	52.50	157.00
<p>3. Chablis, Domaine Philippe Testut Burgundy, France (Magnum) Tight, racy and classic, with minerality, depth and a gorgeous steely structure. Another great Chablis from this renowned producer.</p>	12.40	17.20	24.30	72.30

<p>6. Puligny-Montrachet, Domaine E Sazuet Burgundy, France A brilliant Puligny 1er Cru from an equally brilliant producer and vintage - Chavy's 2015 Clavoillons is rich, concentrated and with a fantastic streak of minerality and acidity.</p>	23.50	32.70	46.50	139.00
<p>7. Chardonnay, Jordan Estate,  Russian River Valley - Sonoma, USA Aromas of citrus blossom and passion fruit spring from the glass. Flavors of lemon, Asian pear and kumquat with a beautiful weight and roundness.</p>	14.30	19.80	28.10	84.00

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<p>8. Brauneberger Juffer-Sonnenuhr Dr H Thanisch - Mosel, Germany Great weight, elegant with an excellent acidity and intense minerality, giving a beautiful balance.</p>	16.30	22.60	32.10	96.00
<p>9. Gevrey-Chambertin, Domaine Serafin Burgundy, France Beautifully constructed, there is a fine intensity, a taut structure and a very impressive ripe, cherry fruit palate. The tannins are succulent and support the wine very well.</p>	20.80	28.80	41.00	122.50

<p>12. Chateauneuf du Pape, Domaine du Vieux Telegraph, Domaine Brunier - Rhone France (Magnum) A truly wonderful wine showing massive intensity, velvety in texture and brimming with dark fruits supported by firm ripe tannins and Grenache spiciness</p>	30.20	42.00	59.80	179.00
<p>13. Chateau du Courlat, Lussac St Emilion Bordeaux, France (Double Magnum) 100% Merlot and aged for 20 months in one third new oak. Fresh, but very ripe plummy fruits give this wine a really sumptuous feel.</p>	44.80	62.50	89.10	267.00
<p>14. Chateau Leoville Barton 2eme Cru, St Julien - Bordeaux, France A blend of 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Merlot from a difficult vintage but this is a great surprise - deep purple, excellent chewy fruit with finely grained tannins and overtones of cassis.</p>	26.30	36.60	52.10	156.00
