- The Show Committee and/or Judge on hand reserves the right to excuse any exhibitor and/or horse showing unsafe behavior, lameness, unsportsmanlike conduct toward other horses, exhibitors or show staff.
- Martingales and schooling equipment will be allowed in all classes
- Tie-downs, mechanical hackamores, or any other illegal equipment is NOT allowed in any class. If you are unsure about your equipment, please consult the show office.
- **Long pants and boots are required.**
- **Helmets are required in Leadline, beginner and first year rider classes. But are recommended in any class**
- If rider competes in a canter class they may not compete in Walk Trot classes
- Exhibitors will select which high point award they are competing for at the first show they attend
- Exhibitors must show in at least 2 of the 4 shows to be eligible for the High Point awards
- If an Exhibitor rides in Open instead of his/hers age group the points will count for their age group high point

Definitions:

WALK/TROT – Riders may not enter into lope/canter/gallop classes

WALK/WALK or WALK/TROT With Assistance - a handler walks beside the horse but no lead line is used

*** INDICATES** that class is open to all level of riders*

BEGINNER RIDER – Has not shown in a Class A rated show and is fairly new to riding

AGE DIVISIONS – Based on age as of January 1st

TBA - Any type class can be added
