



This is Valentine's Day month. I thought a Bible verse on love between a husband and wife would be perfect. I could have chosen a verse from Song of Solomon (which is a love story filled with romance and passion – right in the Bible). But I chose this verse because it reflects a struggle, a choice and an enduring love.

Here in Genesis 29, Jacob has worked for Laban for 7 years. He is finally ready to marry his love, Rachel. Jacob served seven years for Rachel. They seemed to him but a few days, for the love he had for her.

Even after waiting 7 years, this verse reflects the deep love Jacob had for Rachel (If you know the story, Laban tricks Jacob and Jacob marries Leah, Rachel's sister. Jacob must work 7 more years to marry Rachel) In our modern world, waiting 7 years or 14 years to marry someone you love is unheard of. One has to wonder, couldn't Jacob have just found another wife?

Jacob shows an example of commitment in his love for Rachel. It was his choice to love her. A decision he made every day as he worked for Laban. In this short verse, we see that true love is more than a feeling we find in romance novels and Hallmark movies.

If you are living in difficult times and seasons, time often seems so slow. We wonder if the bad days will ever end. But as you look back after 5 years, 10 years, and as you see your kids are grown, you'll think as Jacob did, because of love this seemed like just a few days.

Prayers Answered At Friendship Camp

Dear Friends, We have some really encouraging news here in

Romania. God has shown his faithfulness and encouraged us by providing the funds for 4 more cabins. So with the money in the account in the USA, that's 5 fully funded now, and a start on number 6. We've been praying for six. We only need to raise \$5,000 more to purchase the last one and complete the huge project of \$36,000. Praise the Lord!

We're actually looking at ordering all 6 cabins, faith believing that the Lord is going to provide the money for the last cabin. We have a work team coming from Scotland the beginning of May so our hope is to have the cabins in position, on their foundations by the time the team arrives. They will then begin cladding them with wood, building the boardwalks and adding the roof over the walks. Pray for an exceptionally dry spring so we can transport them up the dirt road to the camp!

This is the way the "cabins" will look when they arrive to the camp; metal exterior, with two windows, one door, insulated, and electrical wiring in the walls.

UPDATE ON NEW MINISTRY FIELD OF BELIZE

Last month we reported that our Friendship International Board of Director unanimously voted to include Belize as a new, developing ministry field, which allows us to also begin making plans for this year to continue our music program which started last year with a choir called, Cayo Community Choir.

As you may recall we began rehearsals in August and had our first performance which was a Christmas concert, Joy to the World, on December 9, 2023.



This concert proved to be will received by the Mennonite Community of Spanish Lookout and surrounding area, with an attendance that was double the size of the 200 seat meeting hall.

We received many encouraging comments that has led to continuing with the choir this year, with plans for an Easter outreach concert on March 23, Palm Sunday weekend.

The big challenge was to find another venue large enough to accommodate at least 400 people with the possibility of more attending. God has provided what we believe to be the perfect venue for

our second ministry outreach. It's called Oakridge Venue at a ranch on the edge of town.

But this is still another step of faith as we commit to renting the beautiful Oakridge facility, trusting the Lord that he will provide the funds needed to pay the expenses not only for the building, but renting chairs, paying for the proper sound system to fill the 500+ hall, lighting and advertising. Our God

is a big and great God, so we look to Him for His provision.

The vision for this ministry is to be an outreach opportunity for Christians but especially for non-Christian to come to a music event, when often they would never attend a church service.

Please pray for this new ministry, that it will have eternal fruit and many will hear, possibly for the first time, the life-changing message of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, because of His love for the Belizean people.



Another new opportunity has come out of our music ministry. A pastor/overseer for the Belizean Presbyterian Church was at our concert and as a result we have met to explore possibilities of how we might collaborate in helping recruit people to go to Belize to train Belizeans in discipleship and leadership skills, including pastoral ministry. Please pray for this open door. As we seek God's direction.
