DIRECT from Friendship Camp by Callum King, Camp Supervisor

The weather in Romania has been exceptionally mild for the beginning of the year which has allowed us to make a much earlier start at Friendship Camp than normal. We have taken this opportunity to do some ground keeping jobs

before we start with construction and repairs.



Over the years the forest around the perimeter of the camp has been growing further and further in. Costi, Manu and I have been working hard over the last few weeks with the chain saw, weed whacker, tractor, hatchets, forks and rakes to cut back what has grown and reclaim some of the land that the forest had begun to swallow up. The added bonus of this job is that we now have huge piles of branches ready waiting for the camp fires which we have every night throughout the summer.



New Sleeping Accommodations

As you well know from previous UPDATES our main project this year will be to add 6 more cabins which will house 24 more campers each week throughout the summer season. We are happy to announce that we have now raised 85% of our fundraising goal and have the money for 5 of the 6 cabins. God has surprised us through the generosity of brothers and sisters in the USA and the UK. Praise the Lord! Can you help us with

the last \$5,000.- we need for the final cabin?

After long discussions with different manufactures about different options we have decided to opt for a prefabricated cabin kit which we will assemble on-site. The benefit of this option is that we are not restricted to dimensions which can be transported on a truck. This will allow the cabins to have much more aesthetically pleasing proportions. In the coming weeks we will prepare the concrete foundations and the materials for the cabins will arrive in April. We plan to have the structures all built by the beginning of May when we will be joined by a work party from Scotland who will help us with the finishing work.



Camp Truck

Any of you who have been to visit Friendship Camp on a work team or as part of a summer camp team will probably remember our camp truck! We've had the truck many years now but it is strong and invaluable to us. During work time and camp time it's used daily for transporting materials and people up and down to the camp. Last summer on the very last day of camp the engine started to make a worrying noise. We parked the van up at the end of the summer because we knew we didn't need it

again for a while but now we've taken it to the mechanic to get it ready for another season. The cost of the repair is \$650. Can you help?

Summer 2024

We are looking forward to a full summer of camps! We already have 8 weeks of camps booked up and interest from other groups who want to come either for a week, a weekend or just for a day. As always many of the children who will come to camp are from families with limited resources. Many children come to camp fully sponsored through our sponsorship program or at a significantly reduced rate. The cost per child for a week of camp is \$75. So far we have raised sponsorship for 25 children. We'd love to get that number up to 100 children before July so we can have all the places full. Pray with us for God's provision.
