This is a story many of our friends are unaware of, at least in more recent years. Friendship International's Hungarian ministry was a thriving mission for years, under the leadership of Nina Stephenson. Approximately 8 years ago, because of critical health issues, it was necessary for her to leave the mission and return to the States, where she convalesced until her death in 2021.

From the time Nina left the mission, leadership was lacking, until the ministry finally came to an end in Hungary. From then on our beautiful camp and conference center began to deteriorate.

We were concerned but prayed and trusted the Lord. One day we received an email from the Baptist Church in Deberecen, inquiring what our plans were with the Camp, or what we called The Farm.



Over time, they shared with us the growth of the church's outreach ministry to the community and their need for a place like The Farm to start a fairly new ministry for Hungary in assisting and caring for the elderly, a need not many churches have addressed in this country, and not at all in the eastern part of the country, around Debrecen.

They have since also relayed to us that they would like this to be a multi-functional facility to also include a camp environment for

kids, youth and families, as well as a location for regional conferences. They agreed that our facilities, with over 17 acres, could easily accommodate any and all of their future ministry endeavors.

The road to the final transfer of title to the Church was not easy, but at every legal challenge, God made a way and we found favor with the overseeing Judge of our case. Praise the Lord.

After talking with the church committee on several occasions it became clear to them and us that this was the plan God had layed out for our beautiful camp. In the photo at the top of this article you see on May 15, 2024, Del Huff, Director of F.I. shaking hands with Pastor Janos Kiss and turning over the keys to The Farm to the Hungarian Baptist Church of Debrecen.

Not only has this transfer of ownership of The Farm resolved both our mission and the church's needs, but there is a silver lining to this seemingly unsolvable situation; The Baptist Church was Nina's home church the entire time she lived in Debrecen and one of her final wishes before leaving Hungary was that her church would eventually receive possession of the Camp for their use.

#### Recovery Is Coming, Slow But Sure



Praise the Lord! Everything is headed in the right direction. Both Adi and Tabita are seeing improvement in their health. Adi

was able to work at the camp with the Scottish team the first week of May. But he must conscientiously restrict himself from lifting anything over 10 kilo. Tabita's B12 deficiency is improving but very slowly, with significant pain in her legs when she does not rest often, and she is weak. Praise the Lord She was able to go out to the camp and have lunch with the work team, but no more. She will be missed during the camps this summer. Pray for workers to take her place for the almost 9 weeks of camp.

Yesterday Miguel received news about the result of the biopsy.
Unfortunately the

tumor is malignant, and although the doctor who operated on it says that he removed everything, he cannot be confident that there was no metastasism. So he sent Miguel to an oncologist for diagnosis.

The doctor who operated on him has his suggestions for treatment, but ultimately the one who decides what is best is the oncologist.

Today he undergoes an MRI. They already gave him the order to take the result to the oncologist on the day of the visit and that will allow him to make better decisions. Please pray for wisdom for the doctors and Miguel as to the next steps to be taken.
