

In the coming year we are focusing on the establishing of our new school of music and arts in Belize.




**CAYO SCHOOL OF

We believe we now have a better understanding of the path we must follow in order to move forward in 2025.


The steps that have already been taken include:

1. Commitment by several musicians and artists in the area to teach at the school.
2. Taking a survey at our 4 music events in 2024 of a wide range of people. There is significant interest by individuals and parents of children who would register for classes or private lessons in music or art.
3. We have researched the area for a suitable location for the school. There are two options, we rent a building and make modifications to suit our school's unique needs. Or, we build our own school on private property offered by lease, to erect a building with the specifications needed for classroom and private learning, large rooms for art studio, choir rehearsals, class instruction, storage rooms, reception/ waiting area, etc.
4. It will also be required that we are approved by the town counsel to establish such a school in the community. We have spoken with several of the community counsel members, three of whom are already committed to being involved in the school at various levels of leadership or teaching.



5. Finally our biggest challenge to be able to move forward is the funding. We have discussed the cost with a local builder to get an approximate amount needed for building a new school vs. remodeling an existing rental property. The total conceptualized space is 2,400 square feet. The estimated cost for a new building is going to be \$150,000, renting over time is less, but we have no ownership. The cost would also include furnishing the school and buying essential instruments, such as pianos, guitars, ukuleles, recorders, etc.

Below is a *very* rough draft of the school floor plan. It has also been discussed with several of our education staff for input and suggestions. For those friends who have been involved in music and art education, maybe this will make more sense than to others. We believe it is very adequate for what our plans call for.






Let's meet each of these groups and find out about them
