## <u>Treasurers Report was given by Keith Wyrick.</u>

Treasurers report shows favorable balance at this time. Club has approximately \$11,045.92 balance in checking/savings.

Does not include Hunt Club balance of approximately \$4,303.60.

Two significant expenses paid were website expenses of \$1,200.00 and \$1,000.00 to National for insurance premium. Current funds are approximately \$2,000.00 ahead of last year at this

point. Revenue from park use fees should begin coming in during October through the end of the year. Park use fees are due Dec 31. There will be some expense to repair the park Tractor.
