December 8, 2024 Meeting Notes

Meeting

Meeting was opened at 2:30pm by John Etheridge. Approximately 10 members were in attendance.

November minutes were reviewed and approved.

New Member:

Cody Tveten was introduced as a new member.

CRSO report - Steve Cox was not in attendance, but left an update for John to present.

- We need nominations for board members.
- Ed Sprenger is leaving the club and resigning his membership on the board.
- Current nominations include Steve Cox, Dan Packard and Charlie Adams.
- PUF dues are due by December 31, 2024.
- Members were reminded to complete volunteer hours in order to maintain RSO and key privileges.
- Steve is expecting the club to lose 3 members at the end of the year.

Treasury Report was given by Keith Wyrick.

Treasurer report shows favorable balance at this time. Club has approximately \$9,125 balance in checking/savings. Does not include Hunt Club balance of approximately \$5,600.

There were about \$1,000 in expenses last month related to the new security system and supplies for the Festivus.

So far, only about 30% of our members have paid their 2025 Park Use Fees.

- Scheduling more work days
- Using the calendar for non RSO's to request times in advance.

Based on the discussion, this should at least be revisited for further discussion AFTER the current requirements have been filled for 2024.
