STEVE COX - SHOTGUN RANGE

Updated the progress on the shot shotgun range

- Roof frame is in place
 - Roof material needs to be installed
- Need to install trap thrower
- Rodney said we should know in two weeks what the status of the fall trap team is

KEVIN & STEVE - SAFETY

- Kevin 200yd range greater chance to shoot over the berm
- Suggest bore sighting - looking through the rifle barrel to align the scope with the barrel to the target (If you are not familiar with the process of sighting in please contact Kevin or Steve to assign you someone to help you.)
- Purchase a quality spotting scope so you aren't tying up the range to go down to check your target.
- Steve C. on the 200yd range rules - no pistols, 22short
 - Kevin highest drop is about 50 inches with a 22lr
- We do have neighbors at about one o'clock from the burm.
- Cleaned glass out of the shotgun range so we can mow the area
- Thanks to David Squibb for mowing the grounds
- Restrictions on rifles; no 338 Lapua and win mags - these rounds could punch a hole in the pig @200yrds
 - If someone donates steel targets suitable for high power rifles that would be ok
