#### FEBRUARY 2020 NEWSLETTER

Location was in the training trailer at the Wildlife Action PD Chapter park in Coward, South Carolina. The Meeting was called to order at 2:30 PM, February 9, 2020.

- Reconfigure shooting benches, move one bench to where the gate currently is, move gate to where it came from
- Contributions helped build the range and trap house see Larry to contribute we appreciate anything you can give even if it is only \$20-\$25.
- Another \$2000 to finish trap house

Expenditures for the two projects, range and trap house, so far 4100+3200

- Aging membership will make club have to hire work done in the future

- Effective 2021 park use fee will go up to \$75
- Effective 2022 park use fee will go up to \$100
- Marketing research showed ranges with less to offer charge \$200 min.
- Youth sports are exempt from initiation fee
- A question was asked about bringing guests. Steve responded by referring pg 16 of the SOP
- National has realized shooting sports is a good way to attract young people
