#### Changes to South Carolina Gun Law - K. Casper

The same restrictions that apply to concealed carry will apply to open carry, no firearm in courts, churches, federal, state and local government buildings. The application and renewal fee have been revoked. Hopefully this minor change will result in more positive changes in the future.
