LARRY DAVIS - TREASURER'S REPORT

- We're solvent!
- The beginning balance for August was \$11,337 plus income of \$965 minus expenses of \$4,601 left us with an ending balance of \$7,701 in checking. \$3,000 of the expense was for reworking the 200 yard range. Savings has a balance of \$3537.
- The Hunting Club has a balance of \$2,576 plus an income of \$500 no expenses. Leaving a balance of \$3,076.
- Checking account has \$7,701 minus the hunting balance of \$3076 leaving us a balance of \$4,625.
- In addition to the \$3,000 expense for grading we had \$615 for insurance for the range.

Situationally Awareness Fail


