

PDWLA -> Jan 14, 2023 Meeting Notes

Meeting was opened at 9am with prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance... This meeting was intentionally scheduled to be short duration to allow time for election of new officers followed by workday activity and lunch. Approximately 35 (estimate) members were in attendance.

Kevin Casper had 1st time visitor Jim Hale introduce himself to the members present. 2nd time visitor Chapman Whitlock (approved candidate for Park Membership) also introduced himself. Ron Lochner also presented his 3 yr. old son Brayton to the group.

K. Wyrick gave the Treasurer's Report. January to date balance in checking is \$12,382 and \$4002 in the Savings (Reserve) account. Total is \$16,384 (all numbers rounded) Only December expense was \$133 electricity for the block house plus park. After today's meeting there are approximately 20 - 2023 PUF accounts still due. This is a strong financial position for the club.

S. Cox gave a brief CRSO report. There are currently 86 folx on the Range Roster. This is the highest membership we have seen since Covid hit. Only 3 RSOs failed to meet their 2022 volunteer hour commitment. (various reasons) These members will become 2023 RSOs without key privileges....no harm/no foul. Question was asked if "make up" was an option. Our SOP has no provision for this, however members can petition the Board for early key reinstatement. (This confidential process is outlined on pg. 19 of the SOP)

D. Wade requested approval for 6 loads of dirt to be purchased...3 for the Skeet Range and 3 for the Hunt Club at \$167 per load This purchase was approved by member vote. The dirt was delivered during Saturday's workday and trap field leveled by D. Wade and W. Floyd.

S. Cox presented a card signed by those in attendance with a token of appreciation to K. Casper for his (Special) Leadership as PDWLA President... Good job Kevin!

Meeting was adjourned at 9:15 to conduct leadership elections.
