laundry detergent

One of the easiest changes and yet most invasive toxic exposures is thru out epidermis- skin! swap your most likely toxic detergent for Molly's Suds for WHITES

skincare

WHY? See above. <u>Facewash</u>, <u>Hand soap, Hair, Bodywash,</u> <u>Sunscreen</u>.... But do you Tallow? P.S. <u>Toothpaste</u>, <u>mouthwash</u>

cookware

cooking with foil

dishwashing

Chemicals in your average detergent leak into pores of our dishware and further expose our food to contamination.

Also- plastic pods? PVAS! Rosey's or Blueland

food storage

microplastics can be absorbed into our breads, vegetables and beautifully prepped meals - opt for <u>storing in glass</u> and using <u>beeswax wrap instead</u> of Ziploc or ceramic.

air filter
