ON 28 DECEMBER 1814 GOVENOR LACHLAN MACQUARIE HOSTED A NATIVE FEAST IN THE GROUNDS BEHIND ST JOHNS CHURCH, PARRAMATTA ON WHAT IS NOW PARRAMATTA CHURCH ST MALL.

A MONTH LATER ON 18 JANUARY 1815 THE NATIVE INSTITUTE WAS OPENED TO "EDUCATE" LOCAL ABORIGINAL CHILDREN IN THE WAYS OF THE NEW COLONIAL SOCIETY.

THE INSTITUTE BECAME THE FORERUNNER TO OTHER SCHOOLS AND MISSIONS THAT WERE FOUNDED ON ASSIMILATIONIST POLICIES THROUGHOUT AUSTRALIA.

FOR MANY ABORIGINAL PEOPLE THIS MARKED THE ATTEMPTED SEVERING OF ABORIGINAL PEOPLE FROM THEIR TRADITIONAL CULTURE AND LAND AND WATERS, AS WELL AS THE SEPARATION OF ABORIGINAL CHILDREN FROM THEIR FAMILIES.
IN THIS REGARD THE PARRAMATTA NATIVE INSTITUTE IS A SIGNIFCANT SITE FOR ABORIGINAL PEOPLE AND FOR

Native Institute is a significant site for Aboriginal people and for the broader Australian community.
