

Good morning.

The New Mexico State Forester has lifted the Statewide Fire Restrictions on all non-municipal, non-federal and non-tribal lands. McKinley County Fire Restrictions have been lifted as well.

Burning requires a permit. Burn Permits may be obtained at our offices at 413 Bataan Veterans Street in Gallup.

Campfires are allowed without a permit but must be in a metal or stone burn ring not to exceed 3 feet in diameter and not be over 3 feet in flame height. Any campfire outside of these limits would require a permit.

The Navajo Nation is still under Stage 1 Fire Restrictions, so no open burning on Navajo Nation lands unless have permit from Navajo Nation EPA.
