Notice of Spearfishing Competition | Sign-on, Sign-off & Briefing | Format & Locations

- The Spearfishing committee is responsible and has the authority for determining if a spearfishing
 competition will be run prior to the scheduled competition date. Competitions may be cancelled,
 deferred or have a change of location or event type based on anticipated marine forecasts, dive
 conditions, availability of boats and numbers of divers attending.
- In the days prior to a competition going ahead an official NOTICE OF SPEARFISHING COMPETITION will be sent to members.
- Dive Calendar is formatted to Queensland Time;
- Tide times are approximate according to the Bureau of Meteorology tide predictions;
- Choice of Locations is generally Tweed Heads, Moreton or Evans Head but other areas may be notified by the Committee.
- **Sign-on** is normally 6:30am AEST (Queensland Time) the Committee will confirm via social media, email or text. Official start times may change due to location of events.
- A pre-dive briefing will be conducted by a member of the Committee and announcements concerning the competition shall be made.
- Boat launch times are generally between 7:00 to 7:30 AEST (Queensland Time).
- **Sign-off** / return time is generally around 13:00 to 14:00 for open boat competitions at the designated boat ramp (confirmed at briefing). All competitors on any boat returning early must still sign-off with the Sign On/Off Clerk via text message or message on the closed Facebook page.

Open Spearfishing Competition

- The Open Spearfishing Championship will be conducted for the duration of the competition year (which commences 1 July each year).
- The competition year is broken up into 4 separate quarters.
- There will be a maximum of 4 competitions per quarter.
- For the Open Spearfishing Championship to be valid, a minimum two competitions must be held during the year for a duration of at least four hours.
- In the event there have been four rounds of the Open Spearfishing Championship conducted in any given quarter the Spearfishing Committee may schedule a Novelty Pelagic Competition.
