Fellow NIPMAC members,

It's great to see that we are making progress with respect to businesses opening during this Covid-19 pandemic. Starting from Friday, July 17th most of the province including northern area are moving into Stage 3 of the recovery plan. This is a major step forward in lifting restrictions on various activities. Under the Stage 3 recovery plan, the maximum number of people allowed in outdoor gathering is 100, and with two-metre (2m) physical distancing.
