Message from our President

Gentlemen,

The Ontario government has started to re-open the economy and gradually lifting restrictions due to Covid-19 pandemic. This is good news. Which means that we are all doing our part in working together to prevent community spread of this virus.

Currently, incident of infections and deaths are in decline. We are "flattening the curve". As the restrictions get lifted, it's crucial that we continue to practice and comply with the instructions and guidelines from the Public Health Services. The compliance is necessary to prevent occurrence of second wave or escalation of infections and deaths.

Safe and healthy practices from the Health Services includes:

- Physical distancing. Maintain at least 2m (6 feet) separation from others.
- Face mask. Wear face mask when 2m separation is not possible in public.
- Sanitizers. Carry container of sanitizers and use frequently.
- Frequent hand washing. Use soap and water to wash hands for at least 20 second.

Message from health expert. "go outside, but don't congregate".

The NIPMAC Executive believes that limited flying could resume at our field, if members follow the instructions and guidelines from the Public Health Services and the governments.

Additional Club's rules:

- No more than five (5) pilots at the flying field. Based on "first come first serve principle", in our case, first arrival at the gate, first of the five (5) on the field. The excess pilots to wait outside the gate until someone vacate the field.
- Entrance gate shall be closed at all times, upon entry.

As more restrictions are lifted, we'll make appropriate changes.

The Health specialist recommends that anyone over 70 years old or with underlying health conditions should stay at home.

The fact is that with everyone playing their part, we are all in better situation now than few weeks ago regarding this pandemic. My friends, just like with past pandemics, this too shall pass with better and healthy days ahead.

Field Opening Protocols

Field opening is subject to the implementation and compliance with the province health and safety guidelines.

Every member is fully responsible for their decisions and actions at the field.

NIPMAC's COVID-19 Health and Safety Protocols

The following guidelines apply to members visiting the club field until further notice:

- 1. Maximum five (5) pilots permitted at anytime. Entry shall be based on "first come first serve principle". In our case, first arrival at the gate, first of the five (5) pilots on the field. The incoming 6th pilot shall wait until a pilot left the field. This is based on the provincial rule regarding maximum of five (5) people permitted for public gathering.
- 2. Physical distancing. Maintain at least 2m (6 feet) separation from others.
- 3. Face mask. Wear face mask when 2m separation is not possible.
- 4. Hand sanitizers. Carry container of sanitizers and use frequently. Wipe any common surfaces touched, such as lock on the gate, trailer or container.
- 5. Keep gate closed behind you after entry the field.
- 6. Do not leave any garbage behind.
