It wasn't until she held his remains that she knew she was in big trouble.



Dexter meets Ace of Spades in this YA thriller with an unreliable narrator battling against her own mind.



How far will she go to protect the ones that she loves? And what will she lose in the process?




### Hey, Brown Girl Book Bio
