



Virtual Salon Trend Gel Competition Rules

Rules

1. This is a 1 hand competition
2. This competition is done on a practice hand with tips.
3. The required elements for the competition are as followed.
4. The practice hand should have all tips well adhered and do not exceed more than 1 cm past the fingertip of the practice hand
5. The tip should be adhered neatly without excessive glue apparent
6. The nails must be enhanced and covered with any type of color gels, gel paint, soak off gel, color gel and gel polish. No traditional nail polish or any type of paints that are not considered a gel. Only gel products
7. The nails should have Salon style nail art with the latest trends.
8. Any color is allowed. There is no limited to the number of colors used.
9. Rhinestones, studs, bullion, foil, tape and glitter and all effects are allowed
10. All free edge shapes are allowed
11. No traditional nail polish.
12. Top sealer must be applied
13. Glue is allowed
14. All General rules apply
15. Total possible points earned 100

Judges Instructions

- **10 points total on all categories.**
- **1 point a nail.**
- **Each nail is judged on its own merit.**
- **The nail must meet all of the criteria for the category being judged to earn its point.**

Nail Shape

- The shape of every nail looks symmetrical. 1 point
- The top of the free edge is filed smoothly 1 point
- All free edge shapes are acceptable, but they must have symmetry.

Product Application

- The product surrounding the proximal nail fold must be within 1mm and have a clean application 1 point
- No excessive product build-up surrounding the lateral nail folds 1 point



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Underside

- No visible dust or debris is allowed. 1 point
- No glue or excessive gel products of any kind. 1 point

Surface Smoothness

- The surface of the nail must feel perfectly smooth. 1 point
- The surface of the nail must not have any air bubbles on the surface. 1 point
- Products that create texture is allowed to be used but must be applied with a clean presentation. Rhinestone and embellishments must not have excessive gel surrounding it. Sugar, chrome, glitters and other effects must be applied evenly.

Top Sealer Finishing

- The top sealer may be shiny or matte but must be applied on the entire surface of the nail. 1point
- There should not be any dull spots on the surface from uncurled products and all gel residue must be well removed. The surface should not have any residual inhibition layer 1 point

Color Application

- The Application of the product should completely cover the surface of the entire nail. Product must be applied evenly with no streaks. The color should look extremely solid with no transparencies. 1 point
 - The tip of the free edge must be covered completely. 1point

Judges Instructions for Artistic Categories

- **Criteria is scored as a total scored**
- **All criteria points awarded are from 1-10**
- **Scores are determined by the judges educated opinion based on the specifics of each criteria**

Level of Difficulty

- The complexity of the design is evaluated on its degree of expertise on each nail.
- The art should be executed in a manner that appears to be difficult on each nail.
- The score is based on the degree of expertise put into the making of the design on each nail.



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Use of Color

- The colors chosen should complement the design
- The colors should represent the design and theme appropriately
- The colors should flow throughout or graduate through all 10 nails.
- The colors should complement and contrast at the same time.

Originality

- The design should be something you have not seen before.
- If the design is something commonly seen, it should be done in a manner that is in a new creative and unusual use of art media.

Creativity

- Creative use with products used.
- There should be a creative collaboration of art and style that is brought together.
- If embellishments are used, there should be a creative manner in which they are used to create the design.
