



Descriptions of Submitted nail art

Flat Art: This competition involves hand painting on tips using various types of paints such as acrylic, airbrushing, water paint, and nail polish. The art is applied flat.

Fantasy Nail Art: In this competition, the work is prepared before the event and is three-dimensional. Any type of nail art product is allowed, except pre-fabricated pieces like decals or ceramic flowers. The model comes in costume to match the nail theme.

Mixed Media / Box Art: The work is prepared beforehand and presented in a viewing box on the day of the competition. It must have a theme and use at least three different art mediums. Pre-fabricated nail art pieces are not allowed.

3D Nail Art Tip Box: These competitions involve creating three-dimensional art on tips using acrylic and gel. The work is done before the competition day and handed in on the day of the event.

Living Art: This competition involves creating art on objects like mirrors, ceramic boxes, mobile phone covers, and jewelry. The artwork can include flat art, 3D art, and embellishments like glitter and rhinestones, usually following a theme.

Salon Trend Pedicure Art: The artwork is prepared before the competition and presented on a black frame on the day of the event. Artwork is applied on pedicure toe tips and should reflect the latest trends in salon art.
