



Description of Hands-on Nail Art Competition

Design Sculpture - Acrylic sculptured nail with forms. The nail art is inlaid into the structure of the nail extension. The shape of the free edge is almond or oval and the nails must be applied thin with C-curves. Gel paint can be used for a portion of the art.

Design Gel Extension - Nails with artistic element inlaid the nail or on top of the nail. All free shapes are allowed. Nails are sculpted with forms. All types of gel are allowed.

Stiletto Nail Art - Sculpted nails with artistic elements added. Acrylic and gel are both allowed. Rhinestones and paints are also allowed. Colored and glittered products are allowed.

Nail Art Embellishment - This competition is done at the competition onto nails that are already applied. The art work is done onto the surface of the nail. All types of nail art are allowed. Pre cast pieces and fimo shapes are allowed. All types of mediums are acceptable. There is always a theme. This is a student competition and does not qualify for Winner of Winners or Grand Champion trophies.

Ultimate Nail Art Challenge - This competition is generally a total of 6 -7 hours where the competitor is required to make 3D nail art and incorporate it onto a set of nail nails with new style nail shapes. The nails should have flat art and embellishments like rhinestones used as well to the art inside the structured nails and 3D. This competition is generally done over two days.

Salon Nail Art Enhancement - This competition is generally for students with 3 hours for 1 hand application. Or a competition for all divisions with 2 hours for 1 hand application. Gel and acrylic are allowed to be used. All shapes are allowed. All types of nail art enhancements may be considered.

French Art Stiletto - This competition is a combination of Stiletto Nail art on French Stiletto . The competitor must use cover pink on the nail plates with smile lines, but it does not need to be extended. Color is used to create the Stiletto tip and nail art can be applied inlaid and on the surface the nail. Both acrylic and gel may be used.
