Just this morning, she texted to tell me that her car is broken down and she has no way to get to work or school. Please pray the Lord will provide for her needs.

A woman with abortion in her past comes to mind. She is pregnant and calls this baby a "miracle". Her living situation is challenging but she is working hard to make a way for herself and her unborn son. Recently, her obstetrician told her that her son is unlikely to survive birth because of a problem with his heart. Yet she is hopeful. We continue to walk alongside her, pray for her, and share hope for her future and that of her baby boy. Please pray for the baby and that God would open her eyes and heart to His steadfast love and affection.

And just this week, a family. Mom, dad, and four kiddos. Dad was incarcerated and is working hard to do better for his family. He wants to be the best dad he can be so he is meeting with our male advocate and taking fatherhood classes. Please pray for this sweet family and that this Dad would recognize God as his faithful Father.

And after sharing just a few stories with you, I would say "thank you". Please, don't miss this. Your financial gifts keep the doors of the Center open so that together we can seek Christ's Kingdom for women, men and families in our community through loving support and practical education in the name of Jesus.
