Our Mission

The Shenandoah County Pregnancy Center is a non-profit Christian, life-affirming ministry that provides loving support and practical education for those facing unexpected pregnancies so that they can choose abundant life in Christ for their families.



An Indisputable Need



Abortions in the US continue to climb and the first six months of 2024 saw a national monthly average of 98,000 abortions. This is an increase from 88,000 per month in 2023 and 81,400 per month in 2022.

Virginia averaged 597 more abortions per month in the first quarter of 2024 when compared to the first quarter of 2023. Virginia saw one of the largest increases in the US.

In 2023, 63% of all abortions were chemically induced, up from 53% in 2020.

95% of pregnancies that end in abortion are unplanned pregnancies.

About 25% of women of child bearing age will abort in their lifetime. 13% of women will abort by the time they are 25 years old.

Our Solution

One of the most prominent reasons women give for choosing abortion relates to the complicated circumstances surrounding their pregnancy.

We are deeply humbled to link arms with our community to help women and men navigate their pregnancy and parenting journey by providing life-supporting resources and services.
