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A Compelling Call to Serve

Nationally, abortion numbers held steady in 2025. However, in Virginia, preliminary data shows a 16% increase in the first quarter of 2025, largely driven by women traveling to the state for abortion services. About 65% of abortions are chemical, and one in three women will experience abortion by age 45. These sobering realities strengthen our commitment to serve and, with your support, expand our impact for life in Shenandoah County.

When Circumstances Cloud Hope

Many women cite difficult life circumstances and a deep sense of isolation as key reasons for choosing abortion. Feeling trapped, unsupported, and without hope, they may come to see abortion as their only option.
