Statistics that compel us...

862,000 unborn children are aborted in the US each year.

15,604 unborn children are aborted in Virginia each year.

There are more children aborted in the US and in Virginia than people who die from heart disease or cancer, the leading causes of death nationally and statewide.

Chemical abortions caused by abortifacient drugs account for 52% of all pregnancy terminations in the US.

Chemical abortions are at-home or self-managed abortions and have increased by 28.3% in Virginia.

1 in 4 women experience abortion during their lifetime.

Over half of US teens are sexually active by age 18.

Qualified Charitable Distribution Giving

Your required minimum distribution can be taken as a qualified charitable distribution and benefits you and the Shenandoah County Pregnancy Center!

A qualified charitable distribution (QCD) is a donation to a charitable organization that goes directly from your IRA account to the charity. Since the donation goes directly to the charity from the IRA (not from the IRA to the individual to the charity), the amount is not counted as taxable income to the individual.

A QCD gift might be right for you if:

- You wish to make a gift without using cash or other assets.
- You do not need all or a portion of your IRA income.
- You want to reduce your taxable income.
- You do not itemize deductions. A rollover gift can reduce your income and taxes so you can still benefit from charitable giving even if you do not itemize.
- You want to give over and above your normal giving. An IRA rollover gift does not count towards the annual limitation on charitable gifts.

Legacy Giving

Options for Legacy Giving:

- Make a bequest to the Shenandoah County Pregnancy Center in your will or trust.
- Designate the Shenandoah County Pregnancy Center as a beneficiary of your retirement account, pension, or other tax deferred plan.
- Name the Shenandoah County Pregnancy Center as a beneficiary of your life insurance policy.
- Give stocks and bonds. A gift of securities is an easy way to make a gift now or as a part of your will. By making a gift of appreciated securities, you can avoid paying capital gains tax that may otherwise be due upon the sale of those appreciated assets. Please contact us for transfer instructions.
