
future where every woman not only hears the truth about the precious life she carries, but also feels fully supported–emotionally, physically, and spiritually–throughout her pregnancy journey.

While the feasibility study will not be complete until after the new year, there are equipment and start-up expenses that we know we will incur. Some anticipated costs for ultrasound and prenatal care include:

- Weight scale
- Devices for vitals–blood pressure, pulse oximeter, thermometer
- Handheld doppler
- Centrifuge
- Medical refrigerator
- Medical exam table
- Ultrasound machine
- Patient data system set-up
- Furniture and equipment for office space and waiting area
- Renovations to the acquired space
- Medically trained professionals

This vision is big and it is bold. And it will take all of us.
