Young and in a difficult relationship, she needed a safe place to be heard and time to think. At the Center, Ashley found a listening ear and reliable information, and she chose to carry her baby.

In early visits, she seemed unsure and often avoided talking about her pregnancy, which caused concern. Today, we're grateful to share that motherhood has changed Ashley. She has fully embraced motherhood and is deeply in love with her baby boy.

John and his partner, Ann, came to the Center expecting their first baby, seeking support through pregnancy and parenting classes. Each week, they were met by Mary, a Volunteer Advocate, who faithfully prayed with them. Over time, John's confidence grew, and he recently asked if he could pray as well. Mary was deeply moved by God's work in John's heart and humbled to witness his faith taking root. John and Ann have since welcomed a healthy baby boy.

The staff and volunteers at the Center have walked alongside **Sarah** for more than two years. A mother of four navigating life on her own, Sarah faced significant challenges after her husband was incarcerated.

With steady support and determination rooted in a faith that inspires those around her, Sarah has made remarkable progress. Today, she is working full time, her children are thriving in daycare and school, she has reliable transportation, and she is confidently managing her household expenses.


Just For Men—Learn about the special role of men at SCPC
