- 426 visits for infant/children's clothing, books, and toys
- 412 baby items like diapers, wipes, and formula shared
- 103 car seats, cribs, and strollers, etc earned by clients through our educational incentive program
- Weekly Mom's Support Group led by a licensed professional counselor
- Spring and fall Abortion Recovery Support Groups led by trained peer counselors
