For more than 30 years, the Shenandoah County Pregnancy Center has walked alongside women, men, and families facing unexpected pregnancies and the challenges of parenting. Through practical support, parenting education, compassionate mentoring, and the hope of Christ, every service is provided free of charge because no family should have to walk this journey alone.

Every dollar raised and every step taken makes that possible by providing:

- **Pregnancy Support:** Pregnancy tests, accurate pregnancy options information, community referrals, and compassionate guidance.
- **Material Assistance:** Diapers, wipes, formula, clothing, baby equipment, and other essentials that ease financial burdens.
- **Education, Mentorship & Support Groups:** Parenting education, fatherhood mentoring, life-skills classes, a Moms Support Group that fosters encouragement and community, and Abortion Recovery Groups offering hope, healing, and restoration.
- **Compassionate Care:** A safe place where trained advocates listen, encourage, pray, and share the hope of Christ.

Because the need continues to grow, we're preparing for our next step. Beginning in Fall 2027, we plan to expand our services to include pregnancy testing and limited ultrasound, allowing us to meet women even earlier in their pregnancy journeys through compassionate medical services rooted in our Christ-centered, life-affirming mission.
