SCSH Pickleball Club Court Rules & Etiquette

Adopted on July 12, 2024 by the SCSHPC

- Pickleball is an enjoyable, recreational and social sport.
- Respect and common courtesy are always expected of all members.
- Foul language or rude personal remarks should be kept to yourself.
- Competition is also part of the game but we all need to play in a comfortable atmosphere.
- Communication with your partner is always important.
- Give the benefit of the doubt to your opponents. Disputed line calls are "in".
- Call out balls promptly, only make calls on your courtside, and use voice and/or hand signals to call "out" balls.
- If the receiving team partners disagree on a line call, the ball is "in".
- Once your game is finished, everyone leaves the court. Paddles up!
- Ensure you have proper court shoes. Do not run backward, do not over-reach, and it is OK not to return a shot. Know your limitations.
- <u>SAFETY</u> is our biggest concern, all players should take frequent water breaks. There is a first aid kit located near the courts.
