

Designated Court Day

Saturday mornings will be Designated Court Day on all of our club member pickleball courts. Designated Courts will allow all club members to play with club members who share their same current club skill rating. Playing with others who share your skill rating allows you to find games that include long rallies and close scoring games.

Combo Courts - There will also be "Combo Courts" where you will be able to play with players one half level up or down from your current rating. This will give you an opportunity to "play up" and test your game. Or "play down" with a friend, partner or spouse who might be rated lower than you. Combo courts can be any combination of players at the two designated skill levels assigned to the Combo Court (i.e. on the 3.5 & 3.0 Combo Court there can be four 3.5 players, one 3.5 and three 3.0, two 3.5 and two 3.0, one 3.5 and three 3.0 or four 3.0 players) Any combination as long as all players adhere to the designated skill rating assigned to that court.

Players may cue up as a single, doubles team, three some or four some. First 4 paddles in the cue are next up. Please be considerate of paddles cued as singles and include them in play.

Saturdays from 8am - Noon courts will be labeled with temporary signs with the designated skill rating for that particular court:

Courts 1 - 6 will cue up paddles on the fence at the appropriate court

Courts 7-10 will cue up on the paddle rack, designated by rating and court number

Play one game, all players rotate off and the next four paddles cued up for that court come on.

Court Hosts will be available for questions if needed. Court Host will assess the number of players present and adjust court designation as needed to prevent long wait times on days with heavy attendance.
