Part 10 - Into The Sanctuary - The Most Holy Place.

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus

Philippians Chapter 2 verse 5

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God communed with His people from the cloud of glory which rested above the mercy-seat, between the cherubim. These golden cherubim with outstretched wings were a representation of the covering cherubim that surround the throne of God in heaven. There can be no government without law. The very suggestion of a kingdom is always connected with law. There could be no judgment without a law as a standard of judgment. God declares that “as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law.” All God’s commandments are righteousness. The establishment or foundation, of His throne is righteousness and judgment.

The Veil And The Most Holy Place:

Directly behind the Altar of Incense was the Veil.
The Veil separated The Holy Place from The Most Holy Place.

The Ark of the Covenant: *Read Exodus 25:10-15*

Note: As we look at the Shekinah Glory on the Mercy Seat between the cherubim, we see the following:

1. The visible presence of God.
2. The visible glory of God.
3. The visible power of God.

3. Upon the Mercy Seat, we see two covering angels at each end. Who do these two angels represent? **Ezekiel 28:14-16** and **Acts 7:55-56** – _____

Note: **1.** They represented Christ and Lucifer. **2.** They are covering their faces with one wing and protecting Gods glory with the other. **3.** They are bowing down as a sign of reverence. **4.** They are facing the Law of God which is a reflection of His character.

Note: The phrase “to propitiate” means the following? “To satisfy the wrath of God against sin”... “To turn away God's wrath”... “To offer a sacrifice that appeases God's just judgment and righteous anger against us and our sin”.

After God had given Moses the instructions on how to build the Ark, He also commanded what should be put into it. At various times in Israel's history, items were added to the Ark of the Covenant in the Most Holy Place. What three objects did the Ark of the Covenant contain?

Note: The stone tables and the words inscribed on them were a symbol of Christ, who is our Rock.

And I say to you that you are **(a)** Peter, and on this **(b)** rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades (death) will not overpower it.

a). = petros (greek) = small stone.

b). = petra (greek) = huge rock

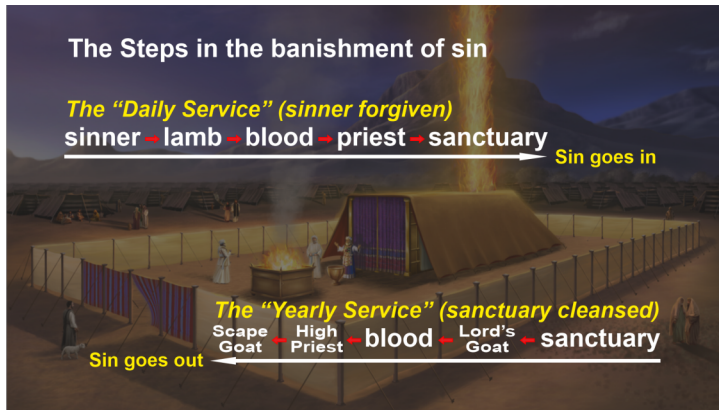
NOTE: The holy law is the standard by which all will be judged. That law will condemn the guilty; for *“sin is the transgression of the law.”* The same law that condemns the sinner will witness to the righteousness of those who, through faith in Christ, have tried to walk in harmony with its holy precepts, humbly seeking forgiveness for every transgression. There is great consolation in the fact that the Lord Himself covered the broken law with a mercy-seat; and then He, the merciful God, took His position upon that seat, so that every sinner who comes confessing his sins, may receive mercy, and pardon. The foundation, of God's throne is righteousness and judgment. That mercy seat, with the cloud of glory, the visible representation of God's presence, and its covering cherubim, is a figure, or *“shadow,”* of the throne of the great God in heaven, who proclaims His name as *“merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth.”*

The Altar of Sacrifice = The Sacrifice of Jesus on Calvary

NB: The Day of Atonement was the removal of the record of sin for one Jewish year.

NOTE: We have journeyed through this study looking at the courtyard, the Holy Place and the Most Holy Place. All three pointed to the work of Christ as He ascended into the heavenly temple. He fulfilled the courtyard sacrifice when He died on earth. He fulfilled the Holy Place as our High Priest and He is now in the second phase of His priestly role in the Most Holy Place. Ultimately, when Christ finishes His work, He will come for the redeemed of all ages. Then after 1000 years, He will return with the holy city Jerusalem and then He will totally destroy Satan and the wicked, thus removing sin from the universe forever.

As we finish, here are 3 points to remember: **1.** The sanctuary demonstrates the plan of salvation **2.** The sanctuary outlines how God solves the problem of sin **3.** Jesus ministers now in the heavenly sanctuary to bring us salvation.

The study of the Sanctuary helps us to understand the role that Jesus is performing right now as we speak. It also helps us to understand that as time is running out, Christ is now in the last phase of His heavenly ministry.
