

A = Adoration **C** = Confession **T** = Thanksgiving **S** = Supplication.

Final overview of The Seven Steps of Sanctuary based prayer:

- 1. The Gate – Start with PRAISE**
- 2. The Altar of Sacrifice – CONFESSION**
- 3. The Laver – WASHED through the WORD**
- 4. The Lampstand – GUIDANCE through the Spirit**
- 5. The Shewbread – STRENGTH for the Day**
- 6. The Altar of Incense – INTERCESSION**
- 7. The Mercy Seat and the Most Holy Place – Experience true INTIMATE COMMUNION with God**

We pray that the Sanctuary based approach to praying will give you an added dimension to your prayer life. You may want to use it as well as the “ACTS” of prayer (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving and Supplication.) Either way, we hope that this study will enhance your prayer life.
