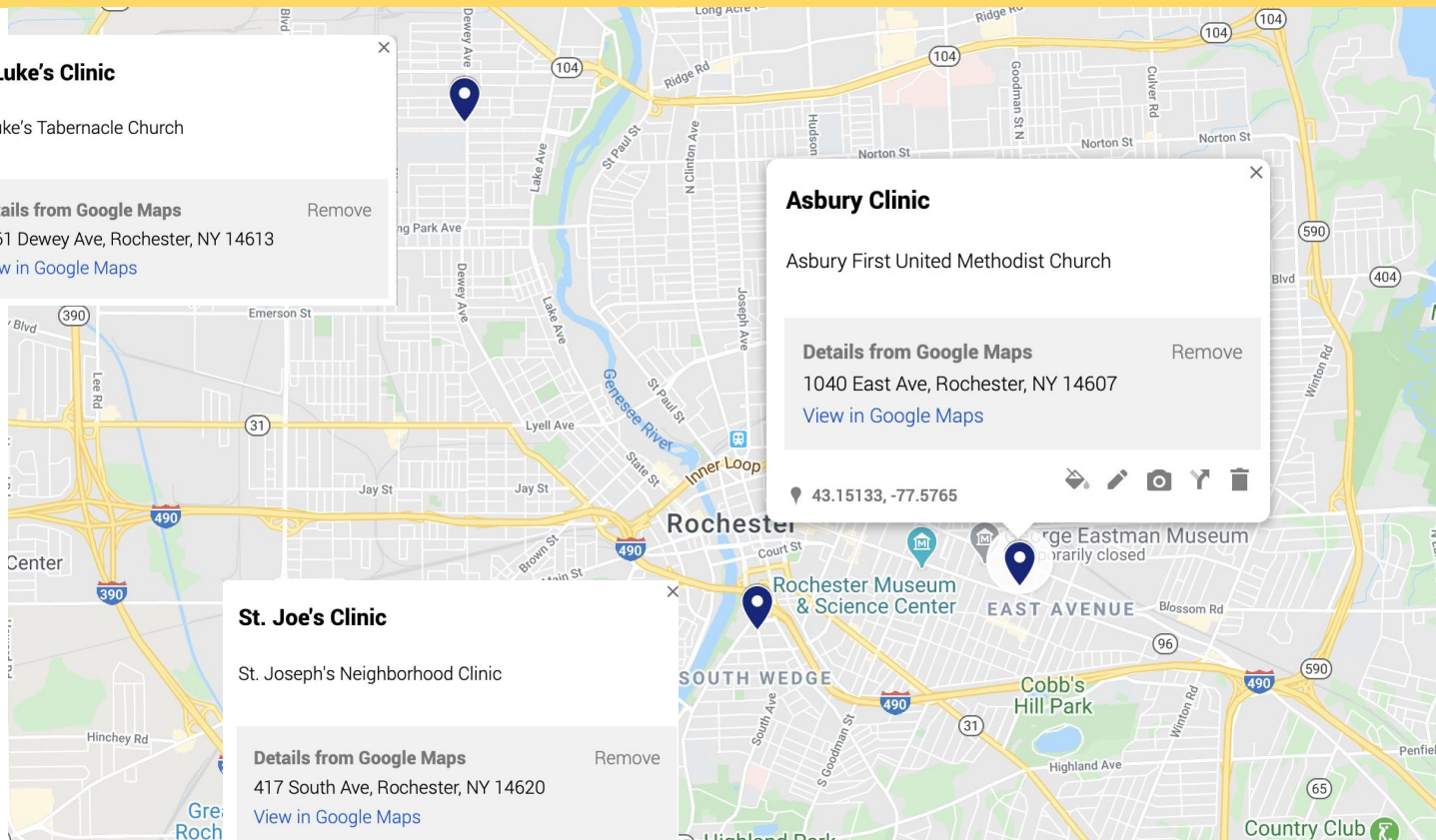

St. Joseph's Neighborhood Clinic

Tuesdays 6-8pm

By appointment. Call (585)-325-5260 to schedule work physicals and specialty night scheduling.

Services offered:

- Pharmacy
- Physical exams
- Screening services for hypertension, diabetes
- Ongoing care for chronic conditions
- Referrals
- Health education and preventative medicine
- Social work, social evaluations to determine patient eligibility for Medicaid programs
- **Specialty care:**
 - Neurology (1x every other month)
 - Ophthalmology (1x/ month): eye exams, vision evaluation, glaucoma and cataract management
 - Endocrinology (1x/month): diabetes and thyroid disease management
 - Orthopedics/MSK (1x/month): musculoskeletal complaints, joint injections
 - Surgery (procedures) (1x/month):
 - PM&R (1x every other month)



What do we offer?



Asbury Clinic

Every Thursday and the First Tuesday of Every Month (Physicals Night)

6pm - 8pm (sign-up starts at 5:30pm)

Appointments are first come, first served. Priority is given to urgent care patients except on Physicals Night (first Tuesday of the month).

Services offered:

- **Physical Exams** (fulfillment of employment/ work/ school/ athletic physical)
- **PPD testing for Tuberculosis**
- STI Testing: for Gonorrhea and Chlamydia only
- Health education and preventative medicine
- Fecal Occult Blood Tests to check for blood in stool
- **Social Work on most clinic nights**
- Flu shot
- Pregnancy tests, condoms, contraceptive information

Services not offered:

- We do not see pediatric patients (children under 18 years old)
- We do not give prescriptions for opioids (ex: Vicodin) or benzodiazepines (ex: Xanax)
- We do not offer vaccinations other than the Flu Shot
- We are not able to assess pregnancy tests or perform urine analysis tests

Wednesdays 6pm - 8pm (sign-up starts at 5:30pm)

Appointments are first come, first served. Priority is given to urgent care patients.

Services offered:

- **Physical exam** (fulfillment of employment/ work/ school/ athletic physical)
- Health education and preventative medicine
- **Social Work**
- **Health insurance advocate available**
- Flu shot
- To take home: Pregnancy tests, condoms, contraceptive information
- We see pediatric patients (children under 18 years old)
- **Spanish-speaking care**

Services not offered:

- We do not give prescriptions for opioids (ex: Vicodin) or benzodiazepines (ex: Xanax)
- We do not offer vaccinations other than the Flu Shot
- We do not read urine pregnancy tests or perform urine analysis tests
- We do not offer PPD testing for tuberculosis
