- Honor Guard Participation: Members of the Fourth Degree often participate in color guards and honor guards at various events, showcasing their commitment to the Order and their community.
- **Veteran Support**: Many Fourth-Degree assemblies actively support veterans and their families through volunteer work and fundraising efforts.
- **Distinctive Title**: Being a "Sir Knight" signifies a higher level of commitment to the Knights of Columbus ideals and provides a sense of prestige within the organization.
