The Bison Bridge

Imagine strolling across the I-80 Bridge with your family in hand, admiring the mighty Mississippi below, the pelicans flying above, and the bison grazing alongside you. It sounds pretty incredible, right? It may even be hard to imagine, especially now since thousands of cars & semis travel over this bridge daily. BUT, this amazing idea and concept comes from the Quad Cities own, Chad Pregracke, and he's had this dream for years! He has dubbed it The Bison Bridge and sees it as the future attraction of our area.

The dream is to reinvent/repurpose the existing I-80 Bridge when it's time for a new bridge to be built (which is soon). This project is in the early stages but is

quickly picking up momentum, thanks to articles like the one in the Chicago Tribune published in April. "It is an outside-the-box idea, and some people would say it's crazy, " Pregracke said for the Tribune. "But if it were anything but that, would people really stop here to see it? It has to have some level of crazy for someone to say, 'I have to see that for myself.'"

After seeing the renderings and hearing Chad speak about this dream and vision—it's really hard not to feel the excitement and magic of this "outside-the-box idea." However, the vision itself will not make this a reality. The fate of the current I-80 bridge lies with the State of Illinois Department of Transportation, along with the United States Department of Transportation, Federal Highways Administration, and the lowa Department of Transportation. The Bison Bridge Foundation's mission is to show these agencies the benefit of building a new structure while repurposing the existing bridge to be the one and only of it's kind in the world, The Bison Bridge.

The Bison Bridge Foundation's main focus right now is looking for support in the form of signatures and by doing so; they hope to show by public opinion that this one-of-a-kind bridge would be a worthy investment. Per their website, "Phase I engineering is now underway in Winter 2021, and it is this phase in which our opportunity lies to get our project considered for approval by the State of Illinois and the Federal Highways Administration."

The long-term goal for this project is to claim a National Park title but first we need to show up and join the herd. Join the movement by signing your support on BisonBridge.org, volunteering for the cause, posting the Bison Bridge logo on your business (or on your car, shirt, hat, dog, it all works), and just by SHARING the word!





A Brief Reflection on LeClaire Chamber in the 21st Century

It is with great pride and joy to reflect on the LeClaire Chamber of Commerce's 40th anniversary.

For the past 23 years, I have had the honor and privilege to play a role in and witness immense growth and positive change in our historic community.

Prior to my tenure during LeClaire's downtown revitalization from 2003 - 2007, Gwen Wigley served as the LeClaire Chamber of Commerce President from 1998 - 2002. I was very fortunate to have learned a great deal from Gwen as I served as a chamber board member. Gwen was an amazing, gifted leader who was transparent, inclusive and authentic. She always had a smile to brighten the day for all she met. Gwen was especially gifted in her ability to bring everyone together during some very challenging times for the LeClaire Chamber of Commerce. At that time, many LeClaire businesses were struggling and seeking direction for sustainability and growth. Gwen was able to help everyone see that there were brighter days ahead for all. This helped set the stage for what was to come.

After Gwen's tenure as President, I was voted in by our membership as President along with Lane Bleeker serving as Vice President in 2002 - 2008. With a host of absolutely amazing board members including Steve Suiter, Chris Cournoyer, Debbie Mulvania, Mike Clingingsmith, Dayle Hall, Deb Willaredt, and Gwen Wigley, a new vision for LeClaire began to emerge.

Seeing the need for a definitive identity, a branding campaign for LeClaire and the Chamber was initiated with donated designs, marketing and advertising from my marketing firm, Adesign, Inc. A new logo and marketing strategy helped secure LeClaire's future as a wonderful community for residents and visitors alike. With the primary vision to revitalize LeClaire for the 21st century, promoting an active Chamber membership became a focus for building strength and unity throughout our community.

With a proactive board driven membership drive, LeClaire Chamber membership quickly exceeded 325 members. Input was sought from all members to understand what they would like to see their Chamber accomplish. Results from the survey called for the Chamber to be proactive in developing community relations and awareness of our existing businesses and to revitalize our downtown area in great need of updating and repair. It was believed that in doing so, a new era of improved relations and pride in LeClaire residents and businesses would result. This would promote expansion and growth as well as encourage new business development. While maintaining the historic and cherished culture of our beloved small town community, this desire for sustainable growth became reality through the dedicated, hard work of all involved.

After meeting with several business owners, community residents, civic


organizations and city hall, a much needed plan for revitalization came into focus as a priority. With the blessing of my board members and city hall, I secured assistance from Iowa State University's (ISU) Planning Landscape and Community Enhancement Program (P.L.A.C.E.). The ISU program involves graduate students, professors and many ISU resources. P.L.A.C.E. chooses only one Iowa community each year to help plan and design a new vision for growth and prosperity.

Fortunately, LeClaire was chosen for 2003. After four months of working with ISU's graduate students, a visionary presentation was proposed to LeClaire city leaders for consideration in November of 2003. Having unanimous support, LeClaire Mayor Vern Spring, Administrator Ed Choate, and council members including Rodney Collier, Mike Wolfe, Bruce Richardson, Debbie Smith, and Mary Farmer were able to secure the nearly 7 million dollars needed to proceed with the revitalization plan in 2004. After working with architects, design engineers and construction firms, our visionary plan was put into action with completion of the levee and main street revitalization in 2006.

After my tenure as President serving from 2002 to 2008, many great board members and Presidents including Lane Bleeker, Debbie Mulvania, Mike Clingingsmith, Dayle Hall, and current President Kathy Anderson followed to continue the legacy of the LeClaire Chamber of Commerce helping LeClaire continue to prosper. Assuredly, the future continues to look very bright well throughout the 21st century and beyond for LeClaire.


