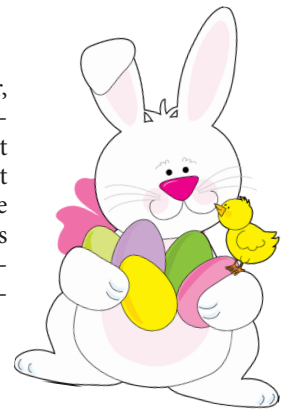
**LECLAIRE FIREFIGHTER'S
